

Tips & Suggestions

If you wear glasses and wish to have photographs taken with your glasses on, may we suggest that you ask your optometrist to borrow a pair of glassless frames, or remove the lenses from your own frames. Glasses may cause reflections and distortion around the eyes, and this will eliminate any problem that might otherwise occur.

Your Sitting Fee

The photography fee of \$35.00 is payable to the photographer at the time of your appointment (cash or cheque - make cheques payable to Fraser Valley School Studios).

This includes 12 sample proofs and photos to be included in the grad class composite and school yearbook.

Your proofs (along with an order form, price list, and ordering instructions) will be sent out approximately two weeks after all students have been photographed.

Booking Your Appointment

Starting on Monday, October 22, go to your school website and click on the Grad Photo Appointment link. Choose your appointment date and time and fill in the required information.

All grad photography will be taken at your school. Please check with the school office for the location.

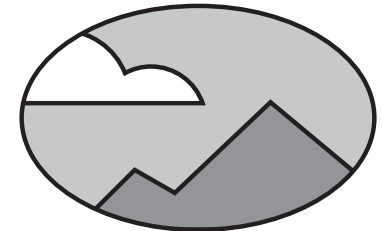

Getting Ready

Be sure to arrive 15 minutes before your appointment to sign in, complete the necessary paperwork, and to ensure that you leave enough time to prepare yourself. A mirror is provided to check your hair, makeup, and smile before starting your photo session, as this is your responsibility along with any other fine details.

Your Photo Session

The photography sitting consists of twelve varied poses of which nine or ten will be taken in a blue grad gown with a blue and gold sash.

The casual photos are optional. If you wish to have photographs taken with sports equipment, team jackets or uniforms, or musical instruments, please bring this along to your sitting. Your photo session will start with the casual poses first, followed by the gown poses. A grad cap is not required, but will be available upon request.

Please inform the photographer if you prefer to have all the poses in the gown only.



For the Girls

Keep it soft and natural and your photos will reflect it. Use regular makeup and touch up all blemishes. Please make sure your foundation is colour corrected to your skin tone and check your teeth after applying lip colour.

It is best not to try a new haircut or hairstyle prior to your photo session.

For the gown poses, wearing a v-neck or scoop-necked top works well if you do not wish to have a collar showing.



For the Boys

Have your hair cut at least one week prior to your photo session. Please keep gel to a minimum as it may show light reflection.

For the gown poses, choose a white or light coloured shirt and a tie that will coordinate with the gown and sash colour specific to your school. Those not arriving with a shirt and tie will have one provided for the gown poses only.

If you have a suit jacket or sports jacket, you may bring it along for the casual photos.
