Secondary Programs (Grades 9-12)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Courses will take place between 8 a.m. and 12 p.m. starting on Tuesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> and for students in Grade 9 will end on Monday, July 29<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>• For students taking Sustainable Agriculture Production 12 this program will run starting on Tuesday, July 2 and will run through July and August (more info to follow)</li> </ul>

## 2. Where will programs take place?

This program is free to B.C. residents and there is a cost of \$423/student for International Students per 40 hour course and for courses that run for four or more weeks there will be a cost of \$846/student.
