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PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Hairstylist Program is a 10- month program located at Chilliwack Secondary School. Students spend one semester of each of their Grade 11 and 12 years in the program completing theory, salon training and 2 on-the-job work practical's. Students complete their other graduation requirements at their regular school during the remaining two semesters.

*Students will graduate on time with their classmates if they successfully complete the program requirements.

PRE-REQUISITES

Student should:

- be in a position to complete graduation requirements
- be mature, responsible, self-motivated, independent learners
- be physically capable of completing the work required in the program
- have a willingness to work at the salon afterschool
- be 15 years of age or older to participate in the program
- be 19 years or under upon completion of the program and not yet achieved Ministry of Education graduation
